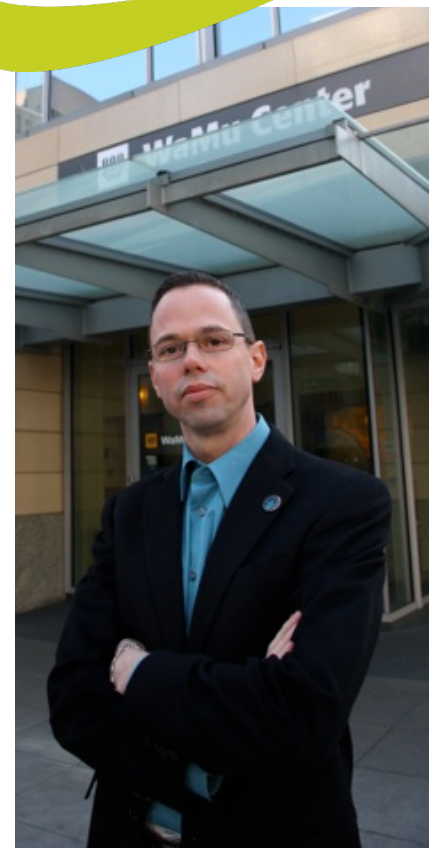
We can lay the foundations for a job-growing economy that will power this region for the next generation.
